On joining the network, members are provided with a current overview of what is happening in the neighbourhood management community. You will also receive information and advice on all aspects of neighbourhood management, from setting it up to putting it into practice, and information on what works. You and your partnership will also be entitled to tailored support and advice to meet your individual needs.

## *What the network will do for you*

### The membership package

*Network commitment:* Short cuts to best practice

# *The advantages of membership*

## 1 Personalised support

*Network commitment:* The Network will be flexible in how it works to meet your partnership's needs.

### Our personalised support package includes:

- access to the Network's best practice advisers. They will investigate your query, provide you with information on what works and put you in touch with experienced practitioners, Neighbourhood Renewal Advisers, or NM Champions;
- support from practitioners in your region: practitioners will be brought together on an informal basis to share views on how to tackle common problems, supporting your personal development; and
- access to the NM helpline. A member of our team can answer any questions you may have about Network services or NM in general.

## 2 Networking opportunities and learning events

*Network commitment:* The Network will provide lively, challenging and knowledgeable speakers at events and create a place for discussion and learning.

### As a member you will be notified of Network events, including:

- large national 'keynote' events;
- smaller regional events;
- regional debates; and
- action teams – small problem-solving working groups.

Network events will give you and your partnership the opportunity to meet others working in the NM field, exchange

ideas and stay up to date with national policies. The Network will also act as an umbrella organisation, bringing you information on other events relevant to NM practitioners.

### 3 E-support - to keep you up to date

*Network commitment:* To save you and your partnership time, the Network will provide concise, up-to-date information on emerging practice, news and policy announcements.

#### As a member you will receive:

- a bi-monthly newsletter to keep you and your partnership up to date with the latest news on policy and practice upcoming events and partnership news;
- a bi-monthly newswire, alerting you and your partnership to emerging news, government policies and publications;
- a network website: [www.neighbourhoodmanagement.net](http://www.neighbourhoodmanagement.net) providing information on Network events and conference reports, latest news, a partnership database, Network newsletters and discussion forums; and
- access to a document exchange service to keep you and your partnership informed about who's doing what. Examples could include board member's handbooks or draft service level agreements.

### 4 Opportunities to influence decision-makers

If you believe in the ability of NM to bring about change, you can take an active part in spreading the word. You and your partnership can help shape the NM agenda by:

- offering feedback at events; and
- working with government departments and bodies to develop thinking on NM.

## 5 Network membership resource pack

The pack will contain:

- a guide to NM;
- a directory of NM partnerships; and
- up-to-date case studies, newsletters, toolkits and evaluation reports.

## 6 Space to work in London

*Network commitment:* Network members are entitled to the use of a London space in which to work or carry out research.

Membership includes use of a members' room with high speed internet connections and access to an NM library. The members' room must be booked one week in advance and is subject to availability.

## *Membership*

There are two membership options:

*Full membership:* You will receive a Network resource pack containing a Guide to NM and a free regional event voucher. You will have free access to personalised support, e-support, action teams, space to work in London and will be entitled to attend events at heavily discounted prices. *Pay as you go:* You will be entitled to purchase individual components of the support package. You will also be kept informed of all events, have free access to the website and action teams.

## Cost of membership

### Standard membership fee £675/year
